## ANNUAL EVENT SHINES LIGHT ON A REASON FOR THE SEASON

VISITING the spectacular Festival of Trees extravaganza has become a longtime tradition for many to emphasize the meaning of the holidays by supporting a good cause.

The Festival of Trees, at the Ford Community and Performing Arts Center in Dearborn, is celebrating its 40th year and typically draws in upward of 7,000 visitors from all over southeastern Michigan. It's one of the largest annual special event fundraisers for the Children's Hospital of Michigan Foundation, raising money for pediatric research for the Children's Hospital of Michigan.

Since its inception in 1985, Festival of Trees has raised over \$20 million for the Evergreen Endowment, and has funded over \$10 million in research grants.

The event kicks off November 23 with a black-tie preview gala offering participation at three levels: VIP tickets are \$175, patron tickets are \$100, children are \$30.

The public is invited to come out and see the beautifully decorated trees, wreaths, centerpieces, kids' activities, and of course, Santa, November 24 through December 1. The event is closed on Thanksgiving Day.
